Wire numbers in a distribution box are used to identify each conductor according to its function, phase, and circuit, ensuring safe installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting.

Main Circuit Wire Numbering

In a distribution box, the main circuit carries large currents and connects devices such as power supplies, circuit breakers, contactors, and motors. Wire numbers follow specific rules to indicate their function and phase:

- Three-phase live wires: Labeled L1, L2, L3 or U, V, W, corresponding to the phase sequence of the supply.
- Neutral wire: Labeled N.
- Ground wire: Labeled PE or identified by a yellow-green color; numbering may not always be present, but the color is standardized.
- Motor circuits: Incoming motor terminals are labeled U1, V1, W1, and outgoing terminals as U2, V2, W2. This helps distinguish connections from contactors to motors.

Wire numbers typically combine letters and numbers, where letters indicate function (e.g., L for phase, N for neutral) and numbers indicate phase sequence or circuit number. Main circuit wires are usually thicker and color-coded red, blue, or yellow-green for easy identification....
