

Afghanistan Fiber Optic Cable Factory



Article Overview

Afghanistan does not currently have fiber optic cable factories; all fiber optic infrastructure relies on imported cables and government-managed deployment.

Current Fiber Optic Network

Afghanistan has developed a substantial fiber optic network, with over 4,000 kilometers of cables already laid across major urban centers and border crossings, and plans to expand to 7,000 kilometers to achieve nationwide connectivity . The network, including the Afghanistan National Ring Network, connects major cities such as Kabul, Herat, Mazar-e-Sharif, Kandahar, and Jalalabad, and links internationally with Pakistan, Iran, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan . Expansion projects, such as the recent 488-kilometer fiber optic extension, are ongoing to connect additional provinces .

Management and Investment

The Afghan fiber optic network is entirely government-owned, managed by Afghan Telecom, deployed by the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, and regulated by the Afghanistan Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (ATRA), . While ATRA has drafted policies to encourage private sector investment, no private fiber optic manufacturing or domestic production of cables currently exists . International companies, such as GL FIBER, supply and deploy high-performance fiber optic cables in Afghanistan, including aerial, underground, and specialized routes for challenging terrains
