Fiber optic cables transmit data using light, offering higher speed, longer distance, and immunity to electrical interference, while electrical (copper) cables transmit data using electrical signals, are more affordable, but are limited by distance and susceptible to interference.

Transmission Medium

Fiber optic cables use light pulses traveling through thin strands of glass or plastic to transmit data, relying on total internal reflection to keep the light within the core . In contrast, electrical cables, typically made of copper, transmit data via electrical currents, which are susceptible to electromagnetic interference and signal degradation over distance .

Bandwidth and Speed

Fiber optic cables provide much higher bandwidth than copper cables, allowing them to carry more data at faster speeds . Photons travel at nearly the speed of light, enabling rapid data transmission, whereas copper cables are limited by the physical properties of electrical conduction and signal attenuation .
