

Burundi Fiber Optic Cable Technology



Article Overview

Burundi is expanding its digital infrastructure through national and regional fiber optic projects, including an underwater cable linking it to Zambia.

National Fiber Optic Network

Burundi has been developing its national fiber optic network since 2012, led by the Burundi Backbone System (BBS) Company. The network involves five major telecommunications companies, including the state-owned Onatel, and is supported by the World Bank's Regional Communication Infrastructure Programme, the Burundian government, and private partners . The first phase of this network was completed in February 2024, aiming to improve broadband access, reduce internet costs, and enhance connectivity across the country . Internet penetration in Burundi is projected to reach 18.33% in 2024, with approximately 2.51 million households expected to have internet access .

Regional Connectivity: Burundi-Zambia Underwater Cable

Burundi and Zambia signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to establish an underwater fiber optic cable across Lake Tanganyika, connecting Zambia's Mpulungu District to Burundi's Makamba Province . This project positions Zambia as a regional ICT hub and allows Burundi to relay information through Zambia, linking it to other Southern and Eastern African countries, including Angola, Botswana, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, Tanzania, and Zimbabwe . A private firm has been contracted to lay the cable, with 350 kilometers already installed, enhancing communication speed, reliability, and accessibility in the regio...
