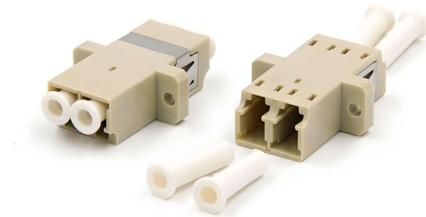


Cable tray installation must reserve loops

Cable tray installations should reserve service loops to allow for future maintenance, equipment changes, and proper cable bending without overstressing conductors.

Purpose of Reserved Loops

Reserved loops, also called service loops or slack loops, are extra lengths of cable intentionally left in cable trays or at termination points. They serve several critical purposes:

- **Maintenance and Repairs:** Loops provide enough cable length to replace or repair equipment without disconnecting the entire system, reducing downtime and labor costs.
- **Future Expansion:** Extra cable allows for rerouting or adding new connections without installing entirely new cables.
- **Bend Radius Compliance:** Loops help maintain the minimum bend radius for cables, preventing insulation damage and ensuring long-term reliability .

Implementation Guidelines

- **Loop Size:** The loop should be large enough to accommodate the cable's minimum bend radius, typically 6–12 inches for standard power and control cables, depending on cable type and diameter .
- **Placement:** Loops are usually reserved near terminations, junction boxes, or equipment connections. In long cable runs, intermediate loops may be placed at accessible points for future modifications .
- **Routing:** Loops should not obstruct tray access or violate fill capacity limits. Maint...
