Cable trays are designed to support and organize cables, not to serve as intermediate cable joints.

Purpose of Cable Trays

Cable trays are structural systems used to securely fasten and support electrical cables in commercial and industrial installations, providing a “highway” for cables that keeps them organized, protected, and accessible for maintenance or future expansion . They come in various types, including ladder trays, solid-bottom trays, ventilated troughs, wire mesh trays, and channel trays, each suited for different cable loads, ventilation needs, and environmental conditions .

Why Cable Trays Are Not Intermediate Joints

Cable trays do not provide electrical connection or splicing functionality. They are intended solely for mechanical support and cable management . Using a tray as a joint could compromise electrical safety, as trays are not designed to handle the electrical continuity, insulation, or stress of spliced cables. Additionally, trays are not rated to contain or protect cable joints from environmental factors such as moisture, dust, or mechanical impact in the same way that proper junction boxes or splice enclosures are .
