

Cables in the secondary distribution box



Article Overview

A secondary distribution box should have phase (live), neutral, and earth cables connected from the main distribution board, with each subcircuit protected by appropriate breakers or fuses.

Main Cable Connections

- Incoming Supply Cables The secondary distribution box receives power from the main distribution board (MDB) or sub-main feeder. This includes:
 - Phase (Live) cable(s): Carries the current to the box.
 - Neutral cable: Completes the circuit for current return.
 - Earth (Ground) cable: Provides safety by preventing electric shock and protecting equipment from faults ().

- Outgoing Subcircuit Cables From the secondary distribution box, cables are routed to individual subcircuits or final distribution points. Each subcircuit should have:
 - Phase cable connected through a Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) or fuse.
 - Neutral cable connected to the neutral busbar.
 - Earth cable connected to the earth busbar, which is linked to the building's grounding system ().

Protective Devices and Cable Routing

- MCBs or Fuses: Each outgoing phase cable should pass through a protective device rated for the load to prevent overload or short circuits.
- Residual Current Devices (RCCB/RCD): Optional but recommended for additional protection against leakage currents. Phase and neutral lines pass through the RCCB...
