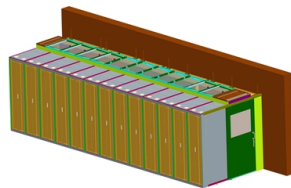


Can the splitter tail wire be connected arbitrarily

It is NEVER, EVER, EVER acceptable to just twist and tape wires together, get your electrician to use Wire Nuts (also known as a BP, cone, thimble, Marrette or Marr connectors) and finish with tape. These connectors should be protected by a junction box and not left hanging in.
