Electrical distribution boxes are high-risk areas that require strict safety precautions to prevent shocks, fires, and equipment damage.

Key Safety Precautions

1. **Avoid Direct Contact with Live Components** Never touch main power supply wires or ground wires inside a distribution box, as these carry high voltage and can cause severe electric shocks or fatalities. Circuit breakers should only be operated when you are certain the environment is safe, and any replacement or repair should be performed by a qualified electrician using insulated tools and protective gear .
2. **Proper Operation Procedures** When powering on a distribution box, always turn on the main switch first, followed by the external power supply. For shutdown, reverse the order: turn off the external supply first, then the main switch. Keep hands dry, operate switches laterally with one hand, and maintain a safe distance from the box .
3. **Maintain Clean and Clear Enclosures** Distribution boxes should remain free of sundries, dust, oil, or debris, which can obstruct ventilation and increase the risk of overheating or short circuits. Avoid installing temporary electrical equipment inside or near the box .
4. **Prevent Unauthorized Access** Secure enclosures with locks, access control, and clear signage to prevent tampering by untrained personnel. Unauthorized access can lead to electrocution, system malfunctions, or equipment damage .
5. **Specialized Environments** In volatile or explosive environments, standard distribution boxes may pose additional hazards. Explosion-proof enclosures are required in such settings, designed to contain sparks and withstand internal blasts....
