

Circuit check for power distribution box tripping



Article Overview

Frequent tripping of a power distribution box usually indicates overload, short circuit, ground fault, or faulty components, and can be diagnosed through systematic inspection and load testing.

Step 1: Identify the Tripped Circuit

Locate the distribution box (consumer unit) and check which breaker has switched to the “off” position. This identifies the affected circuit and helps isolate the problem .

Step 2: Unplug All Devices

Safely disconnect all appliances and devices connected to the tripped circuit. This ensures that the issue is not caused by a specific appliance and allows you to test the circuit independently .

Step 3: Reset the Breaker

Flip the tripped breaker back to the “on” position. If it stays on, the problem may be with one of the appliances. Plug devices back in one at a time, observing if the breaker trips again .
