Common fiber optic patch cords include SC, LC, FC, ST, MPO, MU, MT-RJ, and E2000 types, available in single-mode and multimode configurations.

Fiber Modes

- Single-Mode (SM, OS1/OS2): Yellow jacket, small core ($\sim 9\mu\text{m}$), supports long-distance transmission with low attenuation, ideal for telecom and long-haul networks .
- Multimode (MM, OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5): Larger core ($50\text{--}62.5\mu\text{m}$), supports multiple light paths, suitable for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications like data centers and LANs. Jacket colors vary: OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3 = aqua, OM4 = violet, OM5 = lime green .

Connector Types

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square, snap-in, widely used in PON and enterprise networks .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, duplex, common in modern data centers, fits QSFP transceivers via LC breakouts .
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on, used in high-vibration environments .
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet mount, common in legacy networks .
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications, often used in backbone or data center interconnects .
- MU, MT-RJ, E2000, DIN: Specialized connectors for specific network setups or high-performance requirements
