- **Voltage Verification:** Confirm the pigtail carries the correct voltage using a voltmeter. Always turn off the circuit before handling wires to prevent shock .
- **Connector Inspection:** Check that terminals, wire nuts, or crimp connections are secure and free from corrosion or loose strands .
- **Wire Gauge and Insulation:** Ensure the pigtail matches the system's current and voltage requirements, considering insulation type and wire gauge . Proper electrical pigtail testing prevents intermittent malfunctions, overheating, and potential fire hazards.
