

Configuring device parameters for core switches



Article Overview

Core switch configuration involves setting management IPs, VLANs, routing, interface parameters, and optionally integrating with a network controller for centralized management.

Initial Setup and Access

- Physical and Hardware Checks: Verify the switch model, inspect cables, and ensure indicator lights are functioning properly before powering on the device (Cisco) .
- Console Access: Connect via a console cable using terminal emulation software like PuTTY. Set the serial connection speed (commonly 9600 bps) to access the CLI .
- Login Credentials: Configure initial passwords for console, Telnet, or SSH access to secure device management .

Management IP and VLAN Configuration

- Management VLAN: Avoid using VLAN 1 as the management VLAN. Assign a dedicated VLAN (e.g., VLAN 5) for management purposes .
- IP Address Assignment: Configure the management interface with a static IP address to allow remote access and monitoring .
- Default Gateway: Set a default gateway to enable communication with devices outside the local network .

VLANs and Interfaces

- VLAN Creation: Define VLANs for different departments or network segments. Assign VLAN interfaces with IP addresses for inter-VLAN routing
