

Connect the core switch using a serial cable



Overview

In this guide, you will learn how to connect open networking switches using an RS232-RJ45 cable along with a USB-RS232 adapter. We'll walk you through each step—from preparing the necessary hardware and software to configuring a stable console connection. To establish a serial connection to the console port on the device, complete the following steps. Verify that the device is powered on by verifying that all power LED indicators on the management and interface ports, power supply and fan modules display a steady green light. Note: Under Properties, select VT100 for Emulation mode. Many emulators use this by default, and the location of this setting will vary based on terminal emulator you are using. □□ Step 1: Console Connection Use a serial cable (RJ45 to DB9 or USB-to-serial) and tools like PuTTY, Tera Term, or Minicom. Default settings: Baud rate: 9600 Data bits: 8 Parity:.
