

Connecting PoE switches to non-switches



Article Overview

PoE switches can safely connect to non-PoE devices for data transmission, but power will only be delivered to PoE-compatible devices.

Compatibility Overview

PoE (Power over Ethernet) switches transmit both data and electrical power over a single Ethernet cable, while non-PoE devices and switches only handle data and require separate power sources . You can connect non-PoE devices—like PCs, printers, or standard switches—to a PoE switch without damaging them, as modern PoE switches follow IEEE standards (802.3af/at/bt) and only supply power to devices that request it . Passive PoE switches, however, can pose a risk because they supply voltage regardless of device compatibility .

Connecting PoE to Non-PoE Switches

When integrating a PoE switch with a non-PoE switch:

- **Data Transmission:** The non-PoE switch will forward data normally. PoE power does not pass through non-PoE switches, so any PoE devices connected downstream of a non-PoE switch will not receive power .
- **Uplink Ports:** Most PoE switches have uplink ports that allow them to connect to non-PoE core or aggregation switches without issues .
- **Direct PoE Delivery:** To power PoE devices, they must be connected directly to the PoE switch or use a PoE injector
