

Connection of cable joints inside cable trays



Article Overview

Cable joints inside cable trays should be securely connected using appropriate mechanical methods, properly grounded, and installed with consideration for thermal expansion to ensure safety and system stability.

Mechanical Connection Methods

Cable trays require strong and reliable connections to support the weight of cables and maintain system integrity. Common methods for connecting cable joints include splice plates, bolted connections, quick connect systems, fish plates, clamps, and welding. Splice plates are flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes that are bolted to the ends of two tray sections to join them in a straight line, providing stability and load-bearing capacity. Quick connect systems and clamps allow faster installation and flexibility for future modifications, while welded connections offer permanent strength for heavy-duty applications (Apex Tray) .

Grounding and Bonding

Proper grounding is essential for safety. Metallic cable trays can serve as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC), but each tray section should be bonded using grounding clamps to ensure electrical continuity. If multi-conductor cables with individual EGCs are installed, these should also be bonded to the tray. For aluminum trays, insulated conductors are recommended to prevent electrolytic corrosion, and bonding connections should use tin or zinc-plated connectors. Steel trays have spec...
