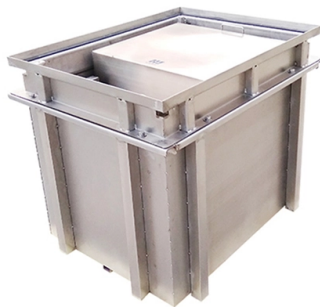


Cross-road optical cable removal plan



Article Overview

Removing a cross-road optical cable requires careful handling, adherence to safety protocols, and coordination with utility authorities to prevent damage and ensure compliance.

Safety and Precautions

Before attempting removal, ensure all power sources are turned off to prevent accidents or equipment damage. Wear protective gear, including gloves and safety glasses, as optical fibers can be sharp and may cause injury if mishandled. Avoid bending, twisting, or crushing the cable, as excessive force can damage the fibers and degrade signal quality.

Disconnecting the Cable

Identify the cable and its endpoints. Most optical cables have connectors at each end that must be carefully disconnected. Grasp the plug, not the cable, and pull straight out to avoid damaging the connector. If the connector is tight, gently wiggle it side to side while pulling. Cover the exposed connectors with protective caps to prevent dust contamination.

Sheath and Armor Removal

For cables with outer sheaths or interlocking armor, use the appropriate stripping tools to remove the jacket without damaging the internal fibers. Follow the manufacturer's specifications for minimum bend radius and maximum pulling force...
