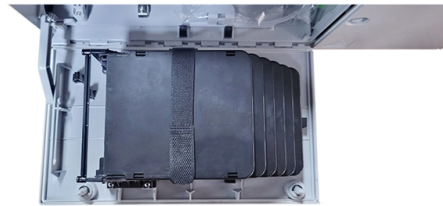

Optical modules follow standardized form factors and interfaces defined by Multi-Source Agreements (MSAs) and industry standards to ensure interoperability, high-speed data transmission, and reliable network performance.

Overview of Optical Modules

Optical modules are hot-pluggable transceivers that convert electrical signals from network equipment into optical signals for fiber links, and vice versa, enabling high-bandwidth data communication . They typically have an electrical interface connecting to the system and an optical interface connecting to fiber cables. Modules can be installed on front panels or directly on printed circuit boards, depending on the design .

Common Standards and Form Factors

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) Family
 - Includes SFP (1–4 Gbps), SFP+ (up to 10 Gbps), and SFP28 (25 Gbps) .
 - Defined by MSAs specifying mechanical dimensions, pinouts, and electrical interfaces, allowing modules from different vendors to be interchangeable.
 - Used widely in enterprise networks, data centers, and carrier-grade deployments.
 - Electrical and optical compatibility must be verified to avoid link failures or high bit-error rates .
