

Distance between the three-level distribution box



Overview

While there is no one-size-fits-all answer, general guidelines suggest that the distribution box should be placed between 5 to 10 feet away from the septic tank. (1) Power distribution from the primary main distribution board (distribution cabinet) to secondary distribution boards can be branched; that is, one main distribution board may supply power via multiple branch circuits to several secondary distribution boards. The horizontal distance between switchbox and fixed electrical equipment should not exceed 3m. If there are some potential safety hazards, we can deal with them in time.
