Distribution box numbering in box plots refers to labeling the quartile groups (1 to 4) that divide a dataset into equal parts to visualize its spread and central tendency.

Understanding Box Plots and Quartiles

A box plot is a graphical representation of a dataset that summarizes its distribution using five key values: minimum, first quartile (Q1), median (Q2), third quartile (Q3), and maximum. The box itself represents the interquartile range (IQR), which contains the middle 50% of the data, while the "whiskers" extend to the minimum and maximum values outside the IQR. Outliers are plotted as individual points beyond the whiskers.

Numbering the Distribution Boxes

In many educational or analytical contexts, the dataset is divided into four equal parts, each representing 25% of the data. These parts are often numbered 1 to 4 from the lowest to the highest values:

- Box 1 (Lower Quartile Group): Contains the lowest 25% of the data, from the minimum up to Q1.
- Box 2 (Second Quartile Group): Covers the next 25% of the data, from Q1 to the median (Q2).
- Box 3 (Third Quartile Group): Includes the 25% of data from the median to Q3.
- Box 4 (Upper Quartile Group): Represents the highest 25% of the data, from Q3 to the maximum. This numbering helps analysts quickly identify which portion of the...
