

Do vertical cable trays in shafts need supports



Article Overview

Yes, vertical cable trays in shafts require supports at specified intervals to ensure structural stability and safe cable management.

Support Requirements

Vertical cable trays must be supported to prevent excessive deflection and to safely carry the weight of the cables. For vertical runs in shafts or risers, typical support intervals are around 900 mm (approximately 3 feet) between supports, although this can vary depending on tray type, material, and load conditions (perforated ladder or solid-bottom trays) . Supports can be provided using wall-mounted brackets, cantilever arms, or hangers from structural members.

Safety and Load Considerations

The weight of cables in a vertical tray generates significant gravitational force. Proper support prevents tray deformation, cable slippage, and potential hazards during installation or maintenance . For long vertical runs, mechanical calculations may be necessary to account for static and dynamic forces, including thermal expansion and seismic activity . In some cases, steel trays of sufficient depth and gauge may be self-supporting for short vertical sections, but horizontal forces still require fastening to walls or columns.
