

Does a ring network fiber optic switch need configuration



Article Overview

To configure a fiber optic switch in a ring network, connect each switch in a closed loop using fiber, enable a ring redundancy protocol like DLR or RSTP, and configure SFP ports for bidirectional communication.

Physical Setup

- **Ring Topology:** Connect each switch to two neighboring switches to form a closed loop. This ensures data can travel in both directions, providing redundancy if a link fails .
- **Fiber Connections:** Use single-mode or multimode fiber depending on distance. For single-strand fiber, employ bidirectional PHYs like 1000BASE-BX, ensuring correct pairing of transmit and receive wavelengths at each link .
- **SFP Ports:** Each switch should have at least two SFP ports for the ring connections. Access ports can be used to connect end devices or additional switches .

Protocol Configuration

- **Redundancy Protocols:** Enable a ring protection protocol to prevent broadcast storms and ensure fast failover. Common options include:
- **Device Level Ring (DLR):** Provides millisecond-level fault detection and reconfiguration, suitable for industrial networks. Requires one switch to act as the ring supervisor and all nodes to have at least two Ethernet ports .
- **Rapid Spanning Tree Protocol (RSTP):** Can be used for Ethernet rings, though failover is slower than DLR
