Overview

To use a patch panel, technicians will typically attach fiber optic cables to the front panel's ports through a process known as 'patching'. A small box on the outside of your home called a NID is installed and the fiber is coiled in there and connected to a fiber that runs into the home. These individual strands will then connect to electronic devices. Here the connection is from a phone switch in a central office or pedestal to the home. Most systems use passive optical network (PON) architectures with signals going through splitters that allow up to 32 users to share one link and carry bidirectional signals.
