- Electric shock: Contact with live 120V or 240V wires can cause severe burns, muscle contractions, or cardiac arrest, especially if skin is wet ().
- Fire hazard: Bare wires can create short circuits or sparks if they touch other conductors or flammable materials, potentially igniting wood, drywall, or insulation ().
- Property damage: Loose or damaged wires can lead to electrical system failures and costly repairs ().

Safety Precautions

- Treat all wires as live: Assume every exposed wire carries current until confirmed otherwise ().
- Shut off power: Turn off the specific circuit breaker controlling the affected area. If unsure, turn off the main breaker to cut power to the entire home ()....
