Key Factors to Consider

1. **Network Role and Architecture** Aggregation switches sit between access switches and core switches, consolidating traffic from multiple edge devices and forwarding it to the core layer. Understanding the network topology—whether enterprise, campus, or data center—is critical to determine the required port density, throughput, and Layer 2/3 functionality . 2. **Port Density and Bandwidth** Select switches with sufficient Gigabit or higher-speed ports to handle current and future traffic demands. High port density ensures that multiple access switches or servers can connect without bottlenecks, while uplink ports to the core should support high-bandwidth connections to prevent congestion . 3. **Layer 2 and Layer 3 Features** Aggregation switches may operate at Layer 2, Layer 3, or both. Layer 2 features include VLAN segmentation, link aggregation (LACP/Static), and multicast control, while Layer 3 features provide routing, IP address translation, and advanced traffic management. The choice depends on whether the network requires routing between VLANs or only traffic aggregation . 4. **Redundancy and Reliability** High availability is essential. Look for VRRP (Virtual Router Redundancy Protocol), MLAG (Multi-Chassis Link Aggregation), and failover capabilities to ensure uninterrupted traffic flow in case of link or switch failure .
