Cable Jacket and Fiber Identification

Fiber optic cables use standardized jacket colors to indicate fiber type according to TIA-598-C. For example:

- Single-mode fibers (OS1/OS2): Yellow jacket, suitable for long-distance communication .
- Multimode fibers:
- OM1/OM2: Orange jacket, legacy networks .
- OM3: Aqua jacket, supports 10/40/100 Gb/s over short distances .
- OM4: Aqua or Erika Violet, higher bandwidth and longer distances .
- OM5: Lime green, designed for SWDM applications and high-speed multi-wavelength transmission . Individual fibers within a multi-fiber cable follow a 12-color sequence for identification: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. For cables exceeding 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with tube and fiber identification, e.g., Fiber #34 is Violet in the Green tube .
