- Cable type: Singlemode (OS1/OS2) or multimode (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4)
 - Fiber count: Common increments include 6, 12, 24, 48, 72, and 144 fibers, with extra fibers often included for future expansion or redundancy
 - Jacket type and color: Indoor, outdoor, armored, or indoor/outdoor; standard colors may be indicated in the part number
 - Construction details: Tight buffer, loose tube, interlock or corrugated armoring, and other protective features
 - Special features: Flame retardancy, water-blocking, or UV resistance for outdoor installations
- Each segment of the long number corresponds to a specific attribute. For example, in some systems like Commscope's, positions in the part number indicate fiber count, tube size, jacket color, and whether a messenger wire is included .
