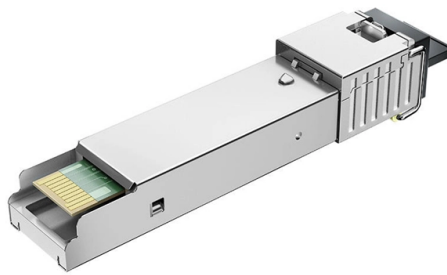


Fiber optic cable not receiving light

A fiber optic cable showing no light usually indicates a physical break, connector contamination, misalignment, or faulty equipment along the link.

Common Causes

1. Physical Damage: Fiber cables are fragile; sharp bends, kinks, or breaks can prevent light from passing through. Even microbends or macrobends along the cable can cause significant signal loss . 2. Connector Issues: Dirty, scratched, or improperly seated connectors are a leading cause of light loss. Dust, fingerprints, or oil on the end face can block or scatter light, and poor termination can create air gaps or misalignment . 3. Equipment Failures: Faulty transceivers, switches, or routers can prevent light from being transmitted. Incompatible or damaged modules may also result in a “Loss of Signal” (LOS) condition . 4. Environmental Factors: Extreme temperatures, moisture ingress, or accidental construction damage can compromise fiber performance . 5. Signal Attenuation: Over long distances, light can weaken due to absorption, scattering, or dispersion within the fiber, especially in older or low-quality cables .

Troubleshooting Steps

- Visual Inspection: Check the cable for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connectors. Ensure all connectors are fully seated .
- Clean Connectors: Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oil from connector end faces .
- Test Signal Strength: Use an optical power meter or OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to measure signal loss and locate breaks or high-loss points
