

Fiber optic cable repair after stripping

Understanding Fiber Optic Cable Structure

Fiber optic cables consist of a core (glass or plastic) that carries light signals, surrounded by cladding to reflect light inward, a buffer for protection, strength members like Kevlar, and an outer jacket for durability. Single-mode fibers (SMF) are used for long-distance transmission, while multimode fibers (MMF) are for shorter runs. Proper repair requires exposing the core without damaging it.

Tools Required

- Fiber optic stripper: Removes the outer jacket and buffer layers without nicking the fiber.
- Fiber optic cutter/cleaver: Produces clean, precise end faces for splicing.
- Kevlar cutter: Cuts strength members safely.
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit: Aligns and joins fibers. Fusion splicing uses heat for a permanent, low-loss connection, while mechanical splicing uses alignment and gel for a temporary or semi-permanent fix.
- Cleaning supplies: Alcohol and lint-free wipes to remove debris from fiber ends.
- OTDR or Visual Fault Locator: Locates breaks and measures signal loss before and after repair
