

Fiber optic cable testing with a cable finder

Using a cable finder or visual fault locator allows technicians to quickly locate, verify, and troubleshoot fiber optic cables by projecting visible light through the fiber to identify breaks, bends, or misalignments.

How Cable Finders Work

A fiber optic cable finder, often called a visual fault locator (VFL), emits a bright red laser light into the fiber. This light travels through the cable, making it possible to:

- Verify continuity between two endpoints
 - Locate breaks or bends in the fiber
 - Identify faulty connectors or splices
 - Check polarity and orientation in multi-fiber connectors
- The light is visible at the other end of the fiber or at points where the fiber is damaged, allowing technicians to pinpoint issues quickly .

Types of Cable Finders

- Standalone Visual Fault Locators Devices like the VFF5 or VisiFault are hand-held, battery-powered tools that project a visible laser into the fiber. They support common connector types (ST, SC, FC, LC) and can operate in continuous or flashing modes for easier fault detection .
