

Home electrical distribution box time delay protection



Overview

100mA S-Type (time-delay) RCDs are used as upstream protection devices where discrimination is essential. They sit ahead of 30mA devices and allow downstream RCBOs or RCDs to trip first in a fault, preventing full-board outages and avoiding nuisance power cuts on critical circuits. The Square D by Schneider Electric Homeline 20 Amp One-Pole Circuit Breaker is used for overload and short-circuit protection of your electrical system. This breaker is compatible with Homeline load centers and CSED devices. I thought that it was only possible to adjust the time delay for circuit breakers belonging to category B. It operates from DC source of 24, 32, 48, 125 or 250 volts. It will stand 110% of rated input voltage continuously over and ambient temperature range.
