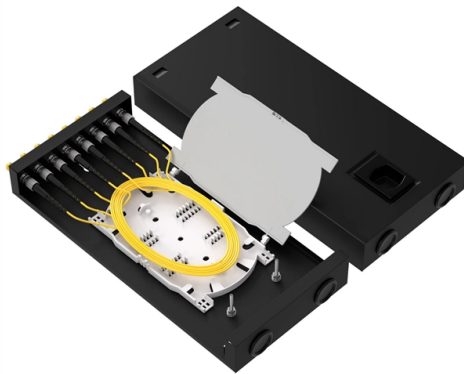


How long should the bare fiber be left in the fusion splicing cable
