Fire Safety and Smoke Emission For public or high-occupancy areas, LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) or HFFR (Halogen-Free Flame Retardant) sheaths are recommended. These materials minimize toxic gas and smoke during fires, reducing risks to people and sensitive equipment . 4. HDPE and thermoplastic elastomers provide high tensile strength and abrasion resistance, while PVC offers moderate flexibility and durability for standard installations .
