Steps for Connecting Cable Trays to Conduits

- Plan and Inspect
 - Confirm the layout, dimensions, and mounting heights of both cable trays and conduits according to approved drawings .
 - Inspect all trays, conduits, and accessories for damage before installation .
- Select Transition Equipment
 - Use cable tray-to-conduit transition fittings or adapters designed to guide cables smoothly into the conduit .
 - Ensure free air space of 1-3 feet is maintained at the transition to prevent cable damage .
- Install Cable Tray and Conduit
 - Securely mount the cable tray and conduit using appropriate supports and bracke...
