

How to connect copper strips in cable trays

Copper strips can be bonded to cable trays using conductive clamps or adhesive copper fabric strips to ensure electrical continuity and proper grounding.

Grounding and Bonding Practices

When connecting copper strips to a cable tray, the primary goal is to maintain electrical continuity and grounding. Metallic cable trays can serve as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC), but proper bonding is essential to ensure safety under fault conditions . Each section of the tray should be electrically connected using grounding clamps or conductive connectors, which mechanically secure the copper strip to the tray and prevent it from being displaced by magnetic forces during a fault . For aluminum trays, bare copper should not be used due to the risk of electrolytic corrosion. Instead, use insulated copper conductors and remove insulation only at bonding points with tin- or zinc-plated connectors .

Using Conductive Copper Strips

Conductive copper fabric strips are a practical solution for connecting copper to cable trays, especially for shielded terminations or EMI/RFI protection . These strips are flexible, durable, and feature dual-sided conductive adhesive, allowing current to flow through both sides. To use them:

- Prepare the surface: Clean the tray section or cable jacket where the strip will be applied....
