

# How to connect fiber optic wall panels



## Article Overview

Fiber optic panels can be connected to the wall by installing a wall-mounted enclosure or patch panel, routing the fiber cable carefully, and terminating it with the appropriate connectors.

### Step 1: Choose the Right Wall-Mount Fiber Enclosure

Select a wall-mount fiber enclosure or patch panel that fits your network requirements, considering the number of fiber strands, type of connectors (SC/APC, LC, etc.), and future expansion needs. Wall-mount enclosures protect delicate fiber cables and provide a central hub for distribution, ensuring organized and reliable connections .

### Step 2: Select the Installation Location

Install the enclosure in a dry, accessible area near power outlets and network devices. Avoid areas with high humidity, extreme temperatures, or potential physical damage. Ensure the wall can support the enclosure's weight and that there is enough space to maintain proper bend radius for fiber cables (minimum 30mm), .

### Step 3: Prepare the Wall

Mark the mounting points using the enclosure template. Drill holes and insert anchors if needed. Secure the enclosure to the wall with screws, ensuring it is level and firmly attached ....
