

How to connect the grounding wire of the main distribution box

Connect the grounding wire from the main panel to the grounding bus bar and then to a properly installed grounding electrode to ensure electrical safety.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Identify the Grounding Bus Bar Open the main distribution box and locate the grounding bus bar, often marked as "PE" or with a green color. This is where all ground wires, including the main grounding wire, will connect . 2. Prepare the Grounding Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local code requirements. Strip the insulation at the end to expose enough copper to make a secure connection . 3. Connect to the Grounding Bus Bar Attach the prepared wire to the grounding bus bar inside the panel. Tighten the screw firmly to ensure a solid connection. If there are other electrical components in the box that require grounding, connect them to the same bus bar using separate copper wires . 4. Connect to the Grounding Electrode Run the grounding wire from the bus bar to the grounding electrode outside your home. This can be a copper-clad steel rod driven at least 8 feet into the ground, a buried metal water pipe, or a concrete-encased electrode. Secure the wire to the electrode using a proper clamp . 5. Safety Precautions

- Turn off all breakers before working inside the panel to prevent electric shock .
- Ensure all connections are tight and free of corrosion.
- Clearly label the grounding wire for future inspection and maintenance
