

How to get cables into vertical cable trays



Article Overview

Cables in vertical cable trays should be carefully laid, secured at regular intervals, and spaced to prevent damage and overheating while complying with NEC fill limits.

Preparation and Planning

Before inserting cables, plan the route and verify the tray type and size. Ladder trays are ideal for vertical runs of large power cables due to their ventilation and ease of securing cables, while ventilated troughs provide continuous support for smaller or sensitive cables. Ensure the tray is properly mounted and aligned vertically, with supports spaced according to load requirements, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart.

Inserting Cables

- **Check Cable Condition:** Inspect cables for damage and confirm they meet design specifications.
- **Organize Cables:** Group cables by type or function to maintain separation and simplify future maintenance.
- **Feed Cables Carefully:** Avoid sharp bends or kinks. Use cable rollers or guides if necessary to reduce friction and prevent insulation damage.
- **Secure Cables:** In vertical trays, fasten cables to the tray's transverse members using approved cable ties or clamps. Standard plastic ties may not meet fire-safety standards, so use listed, UV-resistant ties for outdoor or plenum applications.
- **Maintain Spacing:** Follow design standards for spacing to allow heat dissipation and prevent overcrowding. Do not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area for cabl...
