

How to make fiber optic cold connectors look aesthetically pleasing



Overview

Some methods factory make the connector with a fiber stub which is spliced to the fiber for termination. However, either epoxy or anaerobic adhesives followed by polishing have been determined to be the best methods. Manufacturers have invented and tested many different ways of attaching a connector to that hair-thin strand of glass, including various methods of gluing, crimping or clamping. Required consumables are sold separately. Other steps in the connector termination procedure, such as crimping, involve mechanically. We terminate fiber optic cable two ways - with connectors that can mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear or with splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers.
