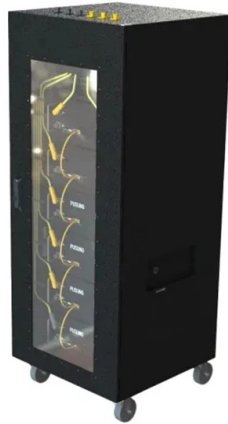


How to make the base of the optical distribution box



Article Overview

A stable base for an optical distribution box can be made by selecting a proper mounting location, using a solid support structure, and securing the box with appropriate brackets or bolts to ensure fiber protection and accessibility.

Step 1: Choose the Installation Location

Select a location that is flat, stable, and accessible for maintenance. For indoor installations, this could be a wall or equipment room floor; for outdoor installations, a pole or concrete pad is common. Ensure the location allows for proper cable entry and exit, and provides enough space for future expansion .

Step 2: Prepare the Base Structure

- Wall-mounted boxes: Install a metal or reinforced wooden panel on the wall to distribute the weight evenly. Use anchors or expansion bolts suitable for the wall material .
- Floor-mounted boxes: Construct a concrete or metal platform that is level and strong enough to support the box and any additional fiber trays. Drill holes according to the box's mounting dimensions and use expansion bolts to secure it .
- Pole-mounted boxes: Use metal brackets or clamps designed for poles, ensuring the box is tightly secured and vibration-free .
