Conduit Material Selection

Choosing the correct conduit material is critical. HDPE (high-density polyethylene) is ideal for most underground and outside-plant installations due to its flexibility, durability, and resistance to moisture and chemical exposure. PVC works well in duct banks and open trenches, while fiberglass is reserved for applications requiring exceptional compressive strength or chemical resistance. For innerducts, corrugated HDPE reduces pulling friction, and smoothwall HDPE is suitable for direct burial, trenchless, or cable-blowing applications. Avoid using riser or plenum-rated innerducts outdoors, as they are not designed for outside-plant conditions .

Conduit Sizing and Fill Ratios

Proper sizing prevents mechanical stress on the fiber. Maintain an initial fill ratio of 40% and a maximum of 70% to allow for future cable additions and reduce pulling tension during installation. Pre-lubricating the conduit with water-based or gel-based lubricants compatible with fiber optic cables is essential, as petroleum-based or silicone products can degrade cable jackets .
