Protective relays should undergo periodic inspection and testing, typically every 1-3 years for electromechanical relays and up to 10 years for modern digital relays with self-diagnostics, depending on operating conditions and regulatory requirements.

Overview of Relay Inspection

Protective relays are critical for detecting abnormal electrical conditions such as overcurrent, undervoltage, or short circuits, and isolating faulty segments to prevent equipment damage or safety hazards . Because relays may operate only rarely, their reliability must be ensured through structured inspection and testing cycles .

Key Steps in Inspection

- Visual Inspection
 - Check for physical damage, corrosion, overheating, or wear.
 - Verify integrity of connections, wires, and terminal blocks.
 - Ensure the relay environment is free from dust, moisture, or extreme temperatures .
- Functional Testing
 - Simulate fault conditions using signal injection or load testing to verify correct relay response.
 - Calibrate thresholds to ensure accurate engagement and disengagement.
 - Periodic calibration maintains sustained accuracy
