

Inspection of Fiber Optic Cable Junction Box

Proper inspection and cleaning of fiber optic junction boxes are essential to maintain signal integrity and prevent system failures.

Key Steps for Inspection

- **Safety First:** Always ensure that all laser sources are turned off before inspecting connectors. Use certified laser safety glasses if required, and confirm with a power meter that no optical power is present in the fibers before handling them .
- **Visual Inspection:** Begin by inspecting all connectors, adapters, and ferrules using a video microscope or inspection probe. High magnification allows detection of dust, dirt, scratches, or epoxy residue that can degrade optical performance . Automated inspection tools can provide Pass/Fail results and save reports for compliance purposes .
- **Check Connector Covers:** Keep protective caps on all unplugged connectors until immediately before mating to prevent contamination . Remove covers only when ready to connect.

Cleaning Procedures

- **Dry Cleaning:** Use mechanical cleaners or dry cleaning strands to sweep the ferrule tip and remove dust particles. This is the first step and often sufficient for minor contamination .
- **Hybrid Cleaning:** If dry cleaning fails, use a combination of solvent (e.g., isopropanol) and dry wipes or swabs to remove stubborn dirt or residue. Always dry the connector completely before reconnecting
