Cold air is supplied through perforated floor tiles or overhead ducts directly into the cold aisle, and servers draw this air through their front intakes. Hot air is expelled into the adjacent hot aisle, preventing mixing and maintaining consistent inlet temperatures.

Cold aisle containment (CAC) involves physically enclosing the cold aisle with barriers or doors to prevent hot air from entering the cold zone. This ensures that servers receive consistent cold air, reduces energy waste, and improves cooling system efficiency. Key considerations include:

- Sealing the aisle: Use panels, doors, or curtains to enclose the cold aisle.
- Airflow management: Maintain positive pressure in the cold aisle to ensure uniform air delivery....
