

Is a junction box a type of distribution box

A junction box is not the same as a distribution box; a junction box connects and protects wires, while a distribution box distributes power to multiple circuits with protection.

 - Distribution boxes are typically larger to accommodate multiple circuits, heavy-duty wiring, and protective devices .
 - Junction boxes are smaller and simpler, designed only to house wire splices and terminations .
- Installation and Use:
 - Distribution boxes are installed near the main power entry point or in centralized locations like basements or electrical rooms to manage multiple circuits safely .
 - Junction boxes are placed at points where wires converge, such as ceilings, walls, or along conduits, to organize and protect connections locally .
- Protection and Safety:
 - Distribution boxes include overcurrent protection devices (circuit breakers or fuse...
