Three-Level Distribution System Overview

A three-level distribution system organizes power distribution into three hierarchical levels from the main power source to the electrical equipment :

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First-Level Distribution Box (Primary/Main Distribution Box): Installed near the power source, it receives electrical energy and distributes it to secondary boxes. It typically contains the main circuit breaker, main leakage protector, voltmeter, and ammeter for centralized monitoring and control .

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Second-Level Distribution Box (Secondary/Sub-Distribution Box): Positioned in power consumption areas or near large equipment, it receives power from the primary box and distributes it to tertiary boxes. It usually contains branch circuit breakers and branch leakage protectors for branch circuit protection .

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Third-Level Distribution Box (Tertiary/Terminal Box): This is the terminal or final junction box that directly connects to electrical appliances or equipment. It can be...
