Purpose of Grounding

A grounding system connects the non-current-carrying parts of your electrical system—such as metal panel enclosures, conduits, and appliance chassis—to the earth. Its main functions are to provide a low-resistance path for fault currents, stabilize system voltage, and protect against electrical shocks, fires, and damage to sensitive electronics during surges or lightning strikes . Grounding works in conjunction with bonding, which connects all exposed metal parts to ensure they are at the same electrical potential, preventing dangerous voltage differences .

Components of a Grounding System

- **Grounding Electrode:** Typically a metal rod (copper or galvanized steel) driven into the earth near the main panel. Other options include metal water pipes or concrete-encased electrodes .
- **Grounding Electrode Conductor (GEC):** A wire connecting the panel's ground bus bar to the grounding electrode. Its size is determined by the service entrance conductors and must be continuous and securely fastened .
- **Ground Bus Bar:** Located inside the panel, this terminal bar connects all ground wires from circuits and the GEC
