

Lighting distribution box in the substation



Article Overview

A lighting distribution box in a substation is a low-voltage panel that manages and distributes power to all lighting circuits, including emergency and operational lighting, ensuring safety and compliance with standards.

Purpose and Function

The lighting distribution box (also referred to as a lighting panel or emergency lighting distribution board) serves as the central point for controlling and distributing electrical power to all lighting circuits within a substation, including control rooms, switchyards, battery rooms, and ancillary areas . Its primary functions include:

- **Power distribution:** Supplies low-voltage AC or DC power to lighting fixtures throughout the substation.
- **Emergency operation:** Connects to backup sources such as diesel generators or battery systems to maintain illumination during main AC supply failure .
- **Circuit protection:** Incorporates miniature circuit breakers (MCBs) or molded case circuit breakers (MCCBs) to protect individual lighting circuits from overloads or short circuits .
- **Control and automation:** Can include automatic switching mechanisms that turn lights on during under-voltage conditions or total AC failure, ensuring operational safety .
