

Methods for handling fiber optic cold connectors

Preparation

Always wear appropriate safety glasses and handle fiber strands carefully to avoid injury . Ensure the work area is clean and free of dust or contaminants.

Fiber Stripping and Cleaving

- Strip the Fiber: Remove the protective coating from the fiber using a fiber stripping tool, exposing the bare fiber without nicking or damaging it .
- Clean the Fiber: Wipe the bare fiber with alcohol swabs to remove any residue or debris .
- Cleave the Fiber: Use a calibrated fiber cleaver to cut the fiber cleanly and evenly, producing a smooth end-face for optimal light transmission .

Mechanical Splicing (Cold Connection)

- Insert the Fibers: Place each prepared fiber end into the precision-molded v-groove of the cold connector, ensuring proper alignment
