

Mobile fiber optic cable directly connected to the router



Article Overview

A fiber optic cable cannot connect directly to a standard router; it requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the light signal into an electrical signal your router can use.

Why an ONT is Necessary

Fiber optic internet transmits data as light pulses, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The ONT serves as a bridge, converting the optical signal from the fiber into an electrical signal compatible with your router via an Ethernet cable . Some ISPs provide combo units that integrate the ONT and router, but in most setups, the ONT is a separate device .

Equipment Needed

- Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP to handle signal conversion .
- Router: Must support Ethernet WAN input; fiber-ready routers can maximize speed .
- Ethernet cable: Cat6 or higher is recommended to maintain gigabit speeds .
- Power supply: For both the ONT and router.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT: Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize
